Creative Writing Presentations

This is an exciting process that helps your child put their thoughts on paper. We have now reached the top of our mountain where the children print three full sentences for presentation. We have added a new presentation tool (a podium!) to assist the children in their posture and volume. As they continue on in school presenting their ideas verbally will be an important skill for each subject they have. I appreciate the time and effort the family gives the student in completing the writing and let me tell you, the excitement the children show to present their hard work is so rewarding to see!

Reading Log

I have attached another reading log to assist in the continued reading of our weekly readers on a consistent basis. If you are currently working on your log please continue to do so and use the attached log when needed. Please note that the log is to be completed for the weekly reader only. The reason for this is that each reader complements the area of the fair we have most recently learned. Your child may place a sticker on each square when they complete a reading of the reader, they may also continue on to the next row of squares even if the week has not yet come to an end. Once the log is complete return it to me for another ticket to our summer marketplace! If you have any questions please feel free to email or phone me at the school or speak to me before class.

A gentle reminder that there is homework available to your child after each class³. The children have been reminded to place the daily sentence sheet in their "front homework pouch" to review with their family. Reviewing the material as it comes home offers a consistent practice towards the weekly reader sent home.
